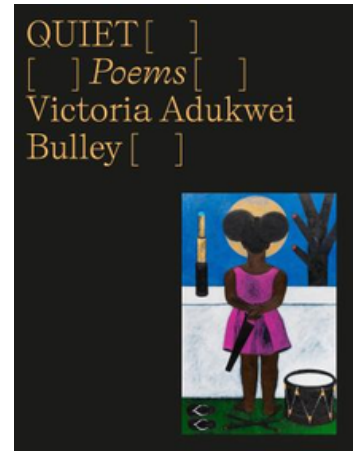
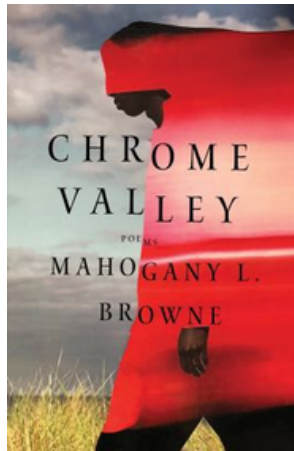
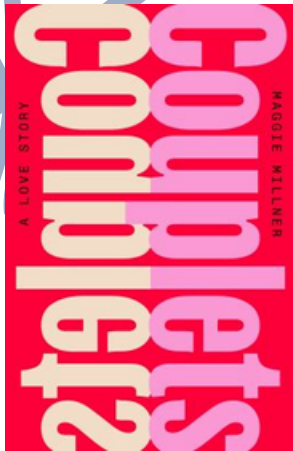
SUMMER STAR GAZING
